OUR PROGRESS...

Good morning and welcome to Papua Merdeka! A monthly newsletter to keep you up-to-date with the struggle of the West people Papuan for selfdetermination and independence. But first, we have a lot of exciting progress to share with you:





Step 1: establish a government

On 1 December 2020, the United Liberation Movement for West Papua (ULMWP) announced the provisional government of West Papua, showing the world that Papuans are united and politically ready to govern their own land.



Step 2: have a plan

It then launched the Green State Vision at COP26. A plan to make West Papua the first green state in Indigenous knowledge, history. democratic values and protecting biodiversity are at the forefront of this Vision.

On the <u>60th anniversary of West Papua's 'Day of Independence'</u>, the Morning Star flag was raised for the first time officially in Vanuatu and in Australia the previous year.

The ULMWP were received by the Basque Country, Spain, the United Kingdom, and significantly, by the Netherlands – West Papua's former colonisers – who broke their 60 year silence to discuss developments in West Papua.

The <u>EU Commission</u> and <u>UN</u> joined 80 other international states in calling for urgent UN access to West Papua. In May, a <u>West Papua support network was launched in the EU.</u>

More and more states & bodies are speaking up about the situation in West Papua.

- 8 <u>students arrested</u> for raising the Morning Star flag.
- Thousands peacefully protest Jakarta's plans to <u>'Divide and</u> <u>Rule'</u> Papua and its renewal of <u>"Special Autonomy Law II"</u>.
- Protestors indiscriminately shot at, arrested and killed.
- UN reported on 100,000 currently displaced, EU humanitarian aid to West Papuans obstructed by authorities, child killings, torture, harassment and disappearances.
- Hundreds of West Papuan scholarships suddenly revoked.
- <u>Pacific Elders</u> call for UN visit to West Papua.
- Newly elected <u>Timor Leste</u>
 <u>President</u> expected to help peacebuilding in Papua.
- Papuan women face <u>'layers of</u> violence'.
